 - a) Briefly describe the major soil groups of India and their characteristics.
 - b) Discuss the distribution and uses of Iron Ore in India.
 - c) Explain the importance of India's geographical location in South Asia.
 - d) What are the main characteristics of the South West Monsoon in Indian subcontinent ?

- a) Divide India into major physiographic divisions and describe the features of the Northern Mountains in detail with suitable diagram. $3+7=10$
- b) Discuss briefly about the growth and distribution of population in India. What are the major population problems of India ? $6+4=10$
- c) Discuss the production and distribution of Rice and Wheat in India. Mention the favorable conditions for their growth. $6+4=10$
- d) Briefly explain the distribution of conventional energy resources (Coal and Petroleum) in India. $5+5=10$
- e) Describe the different types of natural vegetation found in India and the factors affecting their distribution. $8+2=10$
- f) Write an essay on the Iron and Steel industry in India, focusing on its location and importance to the economy. 10
